WHEREAS, Block Love Charlotte, Hearts Beat As One Foundation, Hearts for the Invisible Charlotte, Just Do It Movement, Project Outpour, Promise Resource Network, Leah's Hopes and Dreams, Roof Above, Salvation Army Center of Hope and Supportive Housing Communities, and others upon learning of the order for the residents of Charlotte's Tent City to quickly leave their living environment, joined together to ensure safe and healthy relocation assistance; and

WHEREAS, each group represents volunteers and community partners from throughout our communities, in Mecklenburg County and beyond; and

WHEREAS, staff and volunteers for the aforementioned groups joined together to provide assistance for the residents to identify a variety of important and necessary community resources; and

WHEREAS, the groups recognized the unique needs associated with an action of this type and recognized that many of the residents presented unique challenges, the groups always acted with a focus on the residents' dignity and safety; and

WHEREAS, the groups helped provide assistance to 215 neighbors; and

WHEREAS, all of the groups acted on the needs of their fellow citizens knowing that this was a temporary and short-term solution; and

WHEREAS, residents of Tent City are now receiving important and life-altering wrap-around services as a result of the community's efforts to safely transition these neighbors into county care; and

WHEREAS, due to the already-established relationships with the neighbors of Tent City, the groups were able to create a comfort level for people who struggle to trust government officials; and

WHEREAS, the groups have continued to sustain their boots-on-the-ground effort to support our homeless neighbors throughout this pandemic; and

WHEREAS, all of the groups involved focused on the humanity and deserved respect for all of the residents. They recognized that we are truly our brothers' and sisters' keepers and demonstrated for all of the citizens of Mecklenburg County that each of us is called to act with compassion and love.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mecklenburg Board of County Commissioners does hereby express our deepest thanks and gratitude and recognize the Herculean and tireless efforts of the aforementioned groups and their volunteers to help Mecklenburg County accomplish a massive and seemingly impossible feat.
